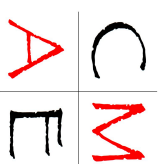

## Conditions of Entry

- All exhibitors must be residents of the Dorrigo Plateau, postcode 2453.
  - Exhibited work must have been created within the last two years.
  - Work previously exhibited in the Creative Mountain Arts Exhibition is not eligible for inclusion.
  - **The entry form, with fee of \$5 per entry, must be received by 31 March.**
  - Commission of 20% will be due to Creative Mountain Arts for each work sold. Commission will be reduced to 15% if the artist volunteers to help stage the exhibition by being on the roster.
  - All entries are to be delivered between 9 AM and 2 PM on Saturday 8 April.
  - All unsold works must be collected between 5 – 7 PM on Sunday 23 April.
  - The maximum number of works is limited as detailed below.
  - The Committee reserves the right to decline any entry, and has the final say on the display and any dispute that may arise.
  - The Creative Mountain Arts Exhibition Committee reserves the right to reproduce any submitted work (without fee) for the purpose of publicity for the exhibition.
  - While the greatest possible care will be taken, the Committee accepts no responsibility for the loss or damage to any entry during the exhibition.
  - Insurance of the work is the responsibility of the artist.
- 2D Work: paintings, prints, photomedia, etc.**  
Limit of five exhibits per artist; one only may be NFS.  
Two works may be a maximum size limit of 1.5 sq.m.  
Work must be framed and ready for hanging. No wet paintings accepted.
- 3D Work: sculpture, ceramics, glass, jewellery, etc.**  
Limit of eight works or sets of works; one only may be NFS.
- Textiles: hand-woven, felted, dyed, knitted, etc.**  
Limit of eight works or sets of works; one only may be NFS.
- Items or sets of items under \$60: \$3 entry fee**
- Cards (or similar) under \$10 each: 1 – 10 items per set, \$5 entry fee per set.**
